

# Little King December

## SYNOPSIS

Victor is trapped in the wrong life. The pragmatic aircraft engineer in his late thirties believes that divorcing his wife Julia was a blessing and that the acute hearing loss he suffers from is not, in fact, a stress symptom. He is certain that his work suits his personality and that working with test pilot Richard is “just fine,” even though Richard is now his ex-wife’s new lover. As a child, Victor was imaginative, musical and creative but his mother managed to cure him of these qualities. It was her who forbade him to talk to Little King December, the peculiar creature who had affectionately accompanied young Victor up until then. Victor was forced to say a tearful goodbye to his imaginary companion. The exact same Little King December, the size of a pencil, wearing a crown and a purple coat, reappears to the adult Victor. Even though Victor desperately tries to ignore him, he stays and makes Victor realize that he has forgotten himself and must try to win his true identity back.

## DIRECTOR

Ralf Huettner graduated from the University of Television & Film in Munich (HFF) in 1985. His feature debut CRIPPLES GO CHRISTMAS in 1987 was a major success and nominated for the European Film Prize. After his follow-up films MUSTERKNABEN (2001), THIRTYSOMETHING (1995) and A MERE FORMALITY (2006), Ralf Huettner won a Grimme Prize for directing the hit series DR. PSYCHO. In 2010 he directed the box office hit VINCENT WANTS TO SEA which won the Golden Lola for Best Film at the German Film Awards. After being awarded with the first-ever Metropolis Prize of the German Directors Association in 2011, he followed up with the family franchise SHIVERSTONE CASTLE 1 and 2.
